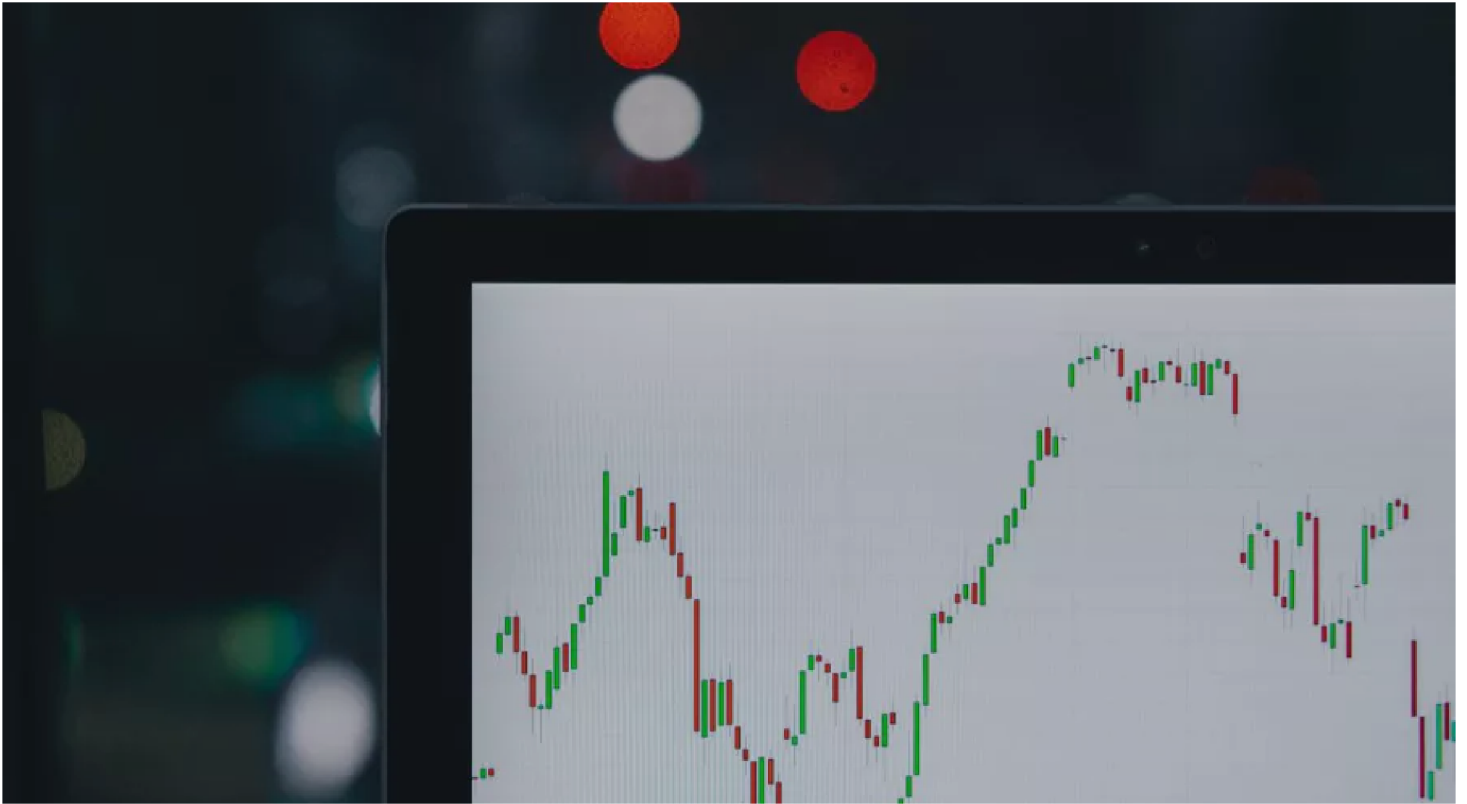


Dropping pay and rampant inflation spells disaster
