


PM must keep vow to save Doncaster Sheffield Airport

The Prime Minister must follow through on her vow to save Doncaster Sheffield Airport, GMB Union has said.

Speaking on BBC's Look North programme last night, Liz Truss said 'I do want to make sure that airport survives'.

The airport's owners, the Peel Group, have announced they would be winding down operations from the week commencing 31 October, despite the offer of public cash to keep it open until a buyer is found.
