GMB union has responded to the the news immigration rules will be relaxed for care workers.

"We have been warning for years about the recruitment black hole for care workers.

"For too long care workers have faced rock bottom pay, no recognition of their skills, and few opportunities for progression. It isn't a surprise that care homes are struggling to fill vacancies when pay is barely above minimum wage.
