

Lack of care home testing a stark warning for ministers - GMB



Concerns about lack of testing from the big care companies should act as a stark warning to Ministers, GMB warns.

Providers such as HC-ONE, Four Seasons Care Homes and Barchester care - who have more than 700 homes between them - report struggling to have their staff tested quickly enough.

Kelly Andrews, GMB Care Lead, said:

"If even the big providers are struggling with testing – where does this leave smaller companies who can't close down homes to protect their vulnerable clients.



"This is yet another Government failure and must be a stark warning for Ministers. Testing the workforce is essential in the fight against covid-19.

"Leaving staff untested for weeks at a time is a recipe for disaster. Not only are workers put at risk, but it could lead to care home deaths rocketing.
