

More than 5,000 to strike in Northern Ireland



More than 5,000 workers in Northern Ireland's civil service, education authority, health trusts and transport sectors are set to strike.

The mass walk out will take place on 18 January.

Workers voted to strike after the Secretary of State failed to provide the funding to address public sector pay a - as well as wider funding issues within health.

Alan Perry, GMB Senior Organiser, said:

"GMB members have simply had enough.
