England's water companies got their worst ever combined score for environmental performance in 2024, the Environment Agency has said.

Andy Prendergast, GMB National Secretary, said:

"Another day, another example of the catastrophic failure of our privatised water sector overseen by a regulator who has consistently failed to regulate.



"For too long the interests of shareholders have been placed above those of staff and customers.

"The long term result is a failing system starved of investment.

"People deserve so much better than ever increasing pollution and higher bills."
