

Political turmoil must not derail Thames Water rescue



Political turmoil must not derail a Thames Water Rescue deal, GMB Union has warned.

The Government is currently negotiating a takeover deal for the stricken water company with a consortium of creditors - but sources say the deal has run into problems in part because of the uncertainty surrounding the Prime Minister's position. [1]

“Thames Water workers have had two years of uncertainty - and a short-term private sector fix will not provide long term stability, clean up the environment, or guarantee jobs, pay, and pensions.
