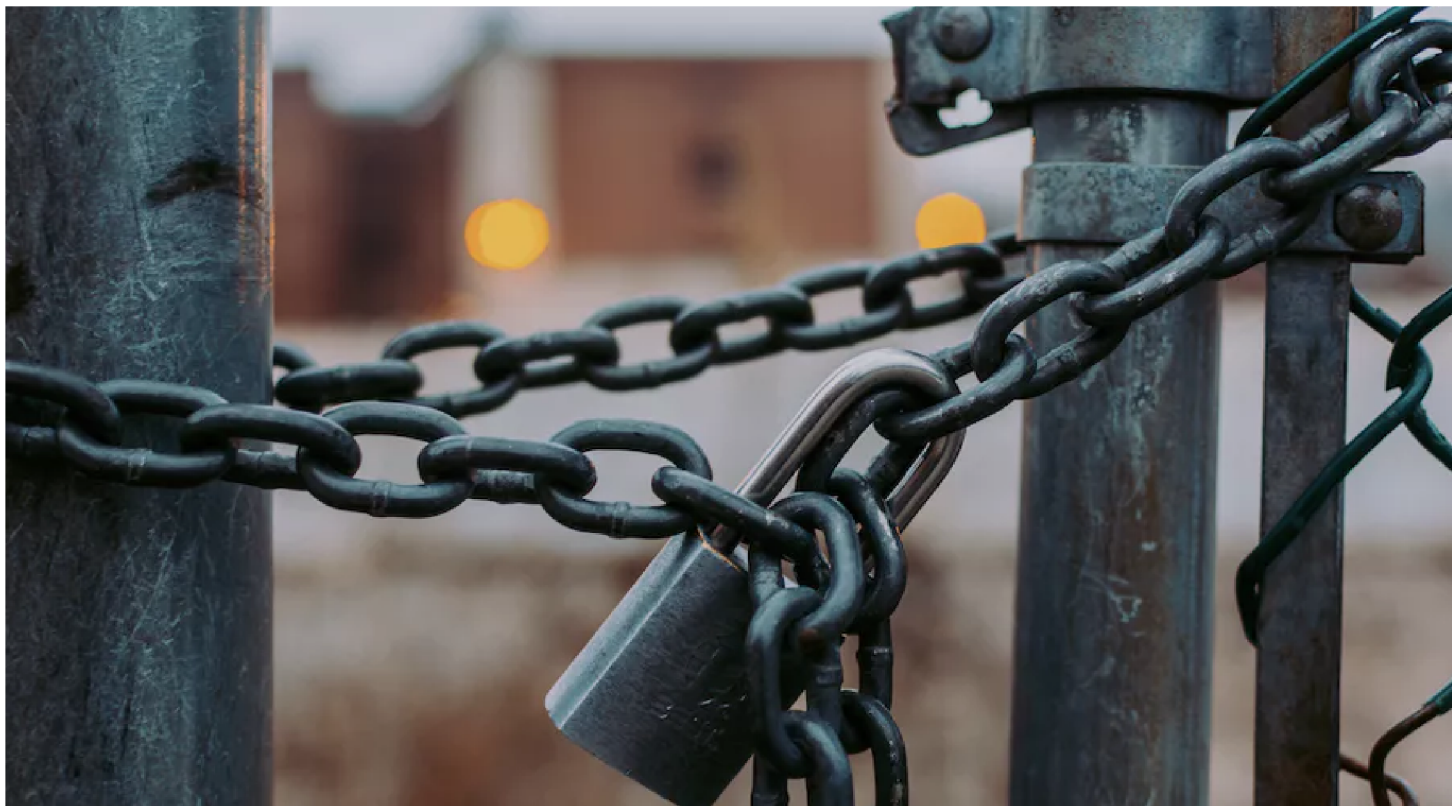


# Dropping employment bill show what Govt think of working people
