

Wages plummet yet PM tells workers to show 'restraint'



They just don't understand what people are going through

GMB Union has responded to today's labour market statistics, which show wages falling at their fastest rate for a decade.

GMB's annual congress takes place in Harrogate this week, 12 - 16 June.

Gary Smith, GMB General Secretary, said:

"Wages are falling at their fastest rate for a decade. People are hurting.



"But this Prime Minister – and the boss of the Bank of England – are happy to tell workers to show restraint; that they shouldn't ask for a proper pay rise.

"It's out of touch and tin-eared. They just don't understand what people are going through."
