- b. Standby and await further information.


2. UPON HEARING THE ALARM (CONTINUOUS RINGING)

- f. PROCEED to the assembly point at the junction of RUSSELL ROAD/ WEST STREET at the rear of the building.
- g. WAIT at the assembly point for further instruction from Brighton Centre staff.
- h. DO NOT leave the assembly point
- i. DO NOT RE-ENTER THE BUILDING without permission.


