PPE fit for all GMB Reps Guide

What's going on?

- PPE must be provided that is suitable and sufficient, but many members, especially women, lack fitting PPE
- H&S legislation exists, but in reality rights are difficult to ensurepeople are unaware of how to challenge bad practice, employers struggle to source items, and there is very little enforcement action.
- The result is that workers are left exposed, which can be deadly in certain industries and roles.

Change is vital to protect workers lives and health.

What needs to change?

In workplaces: Employers must do better at meeting the PPE needs of all their workers, and can do so by following the British Standards Institutions Guidance on Inclusive PPE.

In branches: We need to raise awareness members rights, document issues and tackle bad practice. Start by sharing the nationwide survey.

In law: Some solutions are political, such as funding the HSE to enforce or improving legislation. This campaign is going all the way to parliament!

What can members do?
