

# Diageo strike action suspended as new offer tabled

Responding to Diageo's tabling of a new pay offer for its staff across Scotland on Tuesday 17 September, and the subsequent suspension of strike action, GMB Scotland Organiser Keir Greenaway and Unite Scotland Officer Stevie Deans said:

"We are pleased that on the brink of strike action, Diageo tabled an offer that we feel merits our members' consultation.

**“ Coverage of the last ditch pay negotiations with Diageo today, and of the offer that will be put to our members in distilleries, cooperages, bottling halls and maturation sites across Scotland.**
