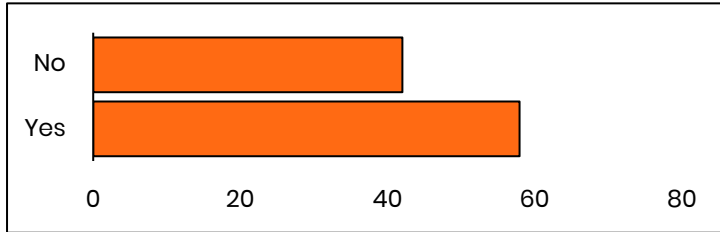




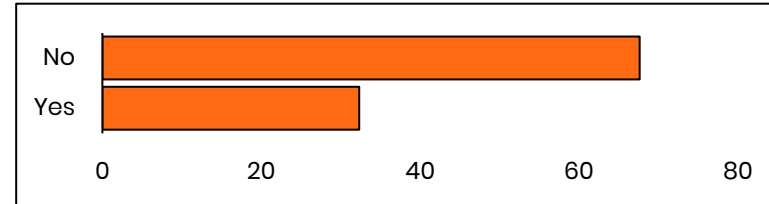
GMB SAFER SCHOOL STAFF SURVEY - TOTAL RESPONDENTS: 7,108

Has there ever been a Covid-19 outbreak in your school? (%)



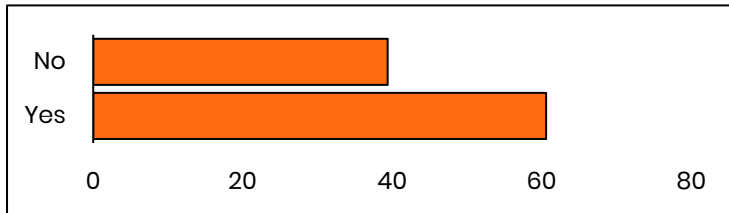

Is testing available in your schools for staff and pupils with symptoms? (%)



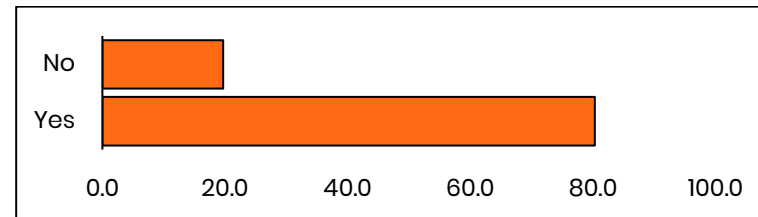

Quotes from the survey:

“I am high risk with diabetes and high blood pressure and I feel worried sick to be in a room with thirty children and three other adults. I do not feel that my health problems are being considered by the Government at all.”

“When there is a covid outbreak, it is kept under wraps and we only find out through staff gossiping about it. Staff have been told to keep quiet about outbreaks they know of and only a few children are kept away when there is an outbreak rather than a whole bubble.”

“We are not safe, somebody needs to get a grip, can we stop pretending that schools are a safe place to be.”

“I’m scared for my life at work...”

“I presented to the business manager with symptoms she took my temperature and because it wasn’t high she said I was ok . The next day I was sent home because I felt terrible. It’s like playing Russian roulette.”

“I am very angry at the Government constantly saying that school is the safest place for children to be, but no mention of it being safe for adults working in the schools!”

“Social distancing is impossible in the staff room. Teachers and support staff are crossing bubbles within the staff room.”
